Hilda was born September 2, 1941 in Grassy Creek, NC. She went to be with the Lord on March 14, 2022. Hilda was the daughter of Critz F. and Margorie B. Lambert of Grassy Creek, NC. After graduating High School in 1959, Hilda moved to Washington DC to work for the State Department. There she met Dennis Kyseth, who also worked for the United States Government. They married Dec. 9, 1964. State Department assignments took them to a variety of settings abroad.

Their first son, Darin Darnell, was born in 1965 in New Deli, India. Eventually they moved back to Washington DC, where their second son, Kevin Edward was born in 1969.

As a homemaker, Hilda supported her husband's varied careers which took them to lead a Marriott restaurant in Leesburg, FL. This is where their son Darin, at the age of four, was killed in a tragic accident. Then, they moved and bought Denny's Sports Shop in Fort Pierce, FL. Next, they owned and operated Arkansas Greenhouses in Springdale, Arkansas. In 1979, they moved to Charlotte, NC where Dennis attended the Heritage School of Evangelism at PTL, in Fort Mill, SC.



After graduating, Dennis worked for The Charlotte Rescue Mission (Rebound) for seven years. In 1990, the Kyseths took on the work of Teen Challenge. While Dennis served as the Executive Director of the Greater Piedmont Teen Challenge, Hilda "mothered" many of the students. She loved them dearly and they reciprocated that love. Many kept in touch, looking to Hilda for prayer and council, even after their retirement in 2010, right up until her passing. Hilda was known by many as a faithful prayer warrior and woman of incredible faith.

Ms. Hilda was a force at Teen Challenge. Her faithful prayers and unconditional love were a huge part of the success of the ministry. She was a loyal and faithful partner to Brother "D". We will miss Ms. Hilda and her prayers, but we rejoice for her to be reunited with her husband, Dennis; her son, Darin, and, most of all, her Savior, Jesus Christ. She was a wonderful example of a Godly leader. We love and miss you, Ms. Hilda. We shall see you again one day.
